- a. AIP 30 Runway Overlay Project The runway project is 120 day project which began August 27th. We estimated the first 90 days would be the concrete work and the last 30 day would be rubber and paint removal and repainting. In actuality the two projects will overlap and the full length of the runway will not be open until on or about December 12th. While the concrete work is complete, there is still work that will needs to done before it can be opened to traffic. The majority of that work is the installation of the RW light extensions. Without the lights functioning, the runway cannot be opened. During the excavation phase we discovered that much of the subgrade material did not have to be removed, which actually saved us money on the project but cost us time in order for the engineers to recalculate materials, resurvey and reevaluate the runway edge elevations. That additional time caused a delay in ordering the runway light extensions which have to be specially manufactured to the new elevation. Attachment 1 Project Schedule

On Nov 26th, work on the existing runway will begin as night work this will shut off all equipment for instrument approaches. During this time the contractor will be doing day and night work.

b. PFC Application 13-07-C-00 LAW – The FAA has approved our new PFC application in the amount of \$ 782,263.00. Of that \$ 172,029.00 is a reimbursement to the Authority for the matching share on projects, \$ 610,234 is the matching share for new projects. This application begins collection on March 1, 2013. **Attachment 2 – PFC Approval**

7. LEASING COMMITTEE (Bob Milner, Committee Chair)

a. La Sill Aviation – LaSill Aviation has requested consideration on their rent each month of the runway construction. The joint Leasing/Finance committee has asked for LaSill's Profit and Loss statements for each month that they are requesting relief for.

Once the information is received and reviewed the committees will make a recommendation on an adjustment for the entire period. In the meantime the committee's recommendation is that LaSill pay their regular monthly rent, as agreed upon in their lease. (*) MOTION NEEDED
